ORDERED as follows:

1. The Motion is **GRANTED**.

2. The Stipulation is **APPROVED**.

3. Scott and Kelli Walchek shall pay, or cause to be paid, the Settlement Payments in

accordance with the terms and deadlines set forth in the Stipulation.

The Settlement Payments or any recoveries from collecting upon the Judgment will 4.

be allocated and apportioned between the Liquidating Trusts pursuant to the Modified Pro Allocation

Formula.

5. MRB's Contingency Fee is approved. The Liquidating Trustee is authorized and

directed to make payment of the Contingency Fee without the need of further Court Order, in

accordance with the Modified Pro Rata Allocation Formula, promptly upon receipt of the Settlement

Payments or from any recoveries obtained in collecting upon the Judgment.

6. The Court retains jurisdiction to enforce the terms of the Stipulation.
