The movant's attorney (or, if unrepresented, the movant) must serve a copy of this notice on all entities required to receive notice and file a certificate of service as required by Local Rule 9036-2. Failure to serve this notice as directed, or to file a certificate of service, may result in denial of the relief requested.
