ORDER AWARDING FOURTH INTERIM POST CONFIRMATION FEE APPLICATION OF JOHN D. EATON AND RASCO KLOCK REININGER PEREZ ESQUENAZI VIGIL & NIETO AS SPECIAL CONFLICTS LITIGATION COUNSEL

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on June 4, 2013 at 10:00 a.m., upon the Fourth Interim Post Confirmation Fee Application of John D. Eaton and Rasco Klock Reininger Perez Esquenazi Vigil & Nieto, as Special Conflicts Litigation Counsel for the Liquidating Trustee [ECF No. 1813] (the "Application").

The Court, having reviewed the Application, having heard from all parties in interest who had an opportunity to be heard, having taken into consideration 11 U.S.C. § 331 and each of the factors that govern the reasonableness of fees as set forth in *In re First Colonial Corp. of America*, 544 F.2d 1291 (5th Cir. 1977) and *Johnson v. Georgia Highway Express*, 488 F.2d 714 (5th Cir. 1974), having heard the argument of counsel, and based on the record, it is

ORDERED that:

- 1. The Application is **APPROVED**.
- 2. John D. Eaton and Rasco Klock Reininger Perez Esquenazi Vigil & Nieto, as Special Conflicts Litigation Counsel for the Liquidating Trustee², is awarded and allowed one hundred percent (100%) of Twenty Two Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty Seven Dollars and No Cents (\$22,767.00) for attorneys' fees, plus one hundred percent (100%) of Thirty One Dollars and Nine Cents (\$31.09) for costs, for a total award of Twenty Two Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety Eight Dollars and Nine Cents (\$22,798.09) ("Fee and Cost Award").
- 3. Pursuant to Section 1.76 of the Plan, and as set forth in the Application, the fees and costs awarded herein are subject to the *pro rata* allocation formula.

4. Pursuant to Section 7.1.11 of the Plan, the Court ratifies payments previously made by the Liquidating Trustee to Rasco Klock Reininger Perez Esquenazi Vigil & Nieto with respect to the Fee and Cost Award.
